

## **This information should be distributed to seniors interested in the Robert Krohman Memorial Scholarship**

Dear Administrator and Applicant,

The NKAPWA is pleased to announce financial support for one graduating senior. This financial assistance is in the form of one \$2,000 (two thousand dollars) scholarship, from the NKAPWA to attend an accredited two or four –Year College or technical school. The award will be based on a 300 to 500-word essay on a subject from the approved list. There are (5) topics to choose from:

- 1) Importance of Maintaining Infrastructure Systems (Parks, Roads, Sewer, Etc.)
- 2) Economic Impacts of Various Approaches to Solid Waste Management
- 3) Value of Park Systems In A Healthy Community
- 4) Managing The Effects of Rapid Development In A Public Works Department
- 5) Solid Waste Management In a Rural Community

### **Eligibility Requirements**

1. Must be a U.S. Citizen
2. Must be a graduate of an accredited high school or home school in Northern Kentucky (Boone, Campbell, Carroll, Gallatin, Grant, Kenton, Mason, Owen, or Pendleton Counties)
3. Must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5
4. Preference given to students attending college or technical school in Kentucky
5. Must not have been arrested and convicted on a drug, weapon or violence charge
6. Must have verification of acceptance in a two or four year college or technical school for the upcoming fall semester before release of funds
7. Must be planning to study in a field similar to one of the following: engineering, construction management, solid waste management, or public administration.

### **Application Requirements**

Applicants must prepare a portfolio that includes the following:

1. Submission of a completed Scholarship Form.
2. Submission of a 250 minimum/500 word maximum essay
3. A letter of recommendation from a school administrator or teacher
