Scholarship Application

The Pendleton County Beef Cattle Association is proud to award a \$500.00 scholarship to a graduating senior of Pendleton County High School who has been accepted to a college/university in the field of agriculture, an agricultural-related field, or currently lives on a farm. The scholarship will be made in two payments of \$250.00 each semester in the name of the educational institution and the recipient.

Any graduating senior regardless of race, creed, color, national origin, or sex is eligible to apply for this scholarship by meeting the criteria specified below and supplying the requested information listed on the application form.

REQUIREMENTS:

- ☐ Applicant must be a graduating senior at Pendleton County High School.
- ☐ Applicant must have been accepted to a college/university for the fall semester following high school graduation. The scholarship must be used the immediate semester unless illness or injury prevents the recipient from attending. If the recipient does not accept or utilize the scholarship in the fall semester immediately following the award, the scholarship is void.
- ☐ The applicant must be entering into the field of agriculture, an agricultural-related field, or presently lives on a farm.
- ☐ Recipient will receive two payments of \$250.00 each semester in the name of the educational institution and the recipient. Successful completion of the fall semester is required before the second payment will be submitted.
- ☐ The Pendleton County Beef Cattle Association Board of Directors will select the scholarship recipient and their decision will be final. Award will be based on need; academic achievement; evidence of school, community, and church involved.
- ☐ If chosen for this scholarship, the recipient must be willing to help the association at the county fair one night in the Beef Cattle Association's Ribeye Booth.

 - Extra-curricular activities in school.
 - Church activities.
 - Community activities.
 - Work Experiences.
 - Honors, Awards, and Leadership Experiences.
